*Beverly Dobrinsky, creator and director of the Carnegie Village Choir presents her solo show DOLJA, with special guests ZEELLIA.*

*DOLJA refers to kismet, destiny, fate; and ZEELLIA is the Ukrainian word for herb, as well as the power of herbs to effect reality, to conjure. DOLJA combines story and song to explore the power and meaning of DOLJA and its sister character KORINNJA--- roots. Beverly first presented a version of this show on Mayne Island in 2009, and in 2010 visited Ukraine for the first time. The impact of that visit has been integrated into the original story to create something new for this performance.*

*In 1991, Beverly created ZEELLIA as a musical vehicle for her Ukrainian Canadian roots. Since then they have been weaving a mystical spell singing and playing Slavic folksongs and dances from Ukraine, the Balkan and Baltic States, and the Canadian prairies.*

*ZEELLIA singers, Carmen Rosen, and Tanya Zaruba join Beverly Dobrinsky for this performance.*
